Just Paint

\$35 per person

Includes all materials: canvases, acrylic paints, paint brushes, aprons, table covers, table easels.

A step-by-step instruction card for each guest.

Includes travel to select areas, set up and pack down.

Minimum 10 guests, maximum 30.

Paint With Me

\$55 per person

Includes all materials: canvases, acrylic paints, paint brushes, aprons, table covers, table easels.

3 hour guided painting class led by artist Bronte Wilkes and step-by step instruction card for each guest.

Includes travel to select areas, set up and pack down.

Minimum 6 guests, maximum 30.

Booking Conditions

The following booking conditions apply to our venue partners when collaborating with Little Art Class.

Booking & Payment

We may require a site visit before booking in the date and time of your event, to ensure practicality of the space. Once all details have been confirmed, final guest numbers are due the day prior to the event, with payment due at the completion of the event. We accept payment via invoice/bank transfer.

Cancellations & Rescheduling

Little Art Class reserves the right to cancel or reschedule an event if minimum ticket sales are not met at least 5 days prior to the scheduled date. In the event this occurs, we will work closely with the venue to determine the best possible solution, which may include rescheduling the class or offering alternative arrangements for ticket holders. It is the venues responsibility to notify all affected participants if this occurs (see ticketing below).

If the venue is required to cancel an event due to unforeseen circumstances, Little Art Class will liaise directly with the venue to determine the most suitable solution. This may include rescheduling the event or arranging an alternative option for participants. Again, it is the responsibility of the venue to notify all ticket holders as soon as possible with updates and next steps.

Venue Access

To ensure a smooth and safe experience, Little Art Class will require access to a sink/running water and power points. Our classes use hair dryers to speed up paint drying times, so we kindly ask our venue partners to provide a suitable space where this won't disturb other patrons.

It is the responsibility of the venue partner to provide suitable tables and chairs for the event and we ask that these are positioned ready for the event prior to our arrival.

We usually require 1-2 hours for set up, but will let you know in the days leading to the event. Pack down usually takes 30mins to an hour.

Ticketing

Ticketing and ticket holder correspondence for an event is to be managed by the venue partner. We're here to support with promotion by sharing the event on our social media platforms and providing images/content. We suggest using humanitix.com/au as a ticketing platform.

Food & Drink Policy

Little Art Class is a pop-up service and does not provide food, drinks or alcohol at any events. We are not responsible for monitoring the safe or responsible consumption of alcohol.

Weather

In the event of extreme weather, power outages or unforeseen circumstances that prevent access to a venue, we'll work with you to reschedule the event at no extra charge.

Travel

Our prices include travel to venues in Albany, Mount Barker, Kendenup, Cranbrook and Denmark. Travel fees for bookings outside of these areas may apply.
